

## LMC PROJECT CASE STUDY

Supporting GPs by developing LMCs and their efficacy

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### THE PROJECT

The development of an LMC Support Network aims to resolve the issue of inadequate support and resources for LMCs by providing a comprehensive, timely, and accessible information and coordination service to help LMCs navigate complex regulations, policy updates, and management challenges effectively.

### SOLUTION

The project will involve the following key elements:

- Increased staffing levels
- Website development, maintenance and enhancement to provide a centralised resource for reference materials, tools, blogs, discussion forums, and FAQs.
- Weekly briefings summarising key news stories and significant policy changes to keep LMC officers informed.
- Training and development to offer training events and opportunities for LMC officers and staff.
- Establishment of a regional governance structure to ensure the project is responsive to LMC needs and owned by LMCs.
- Engagement with LMCs in Scotland and Wales to ensure the network meets the needs of all three nations.
- Induction materials to assist new LMC officers and staff in their roles.
- Continuous collection of feedback from LMCs to improve the relevance, accuracy, and timeliness of the information provided.

### COSTS - 6 MONTHS

- 2 sessions per week of senior exec oversight - £15,600
- 4 sessions per week project management - £10,500
- 1 session per week senior executive input - £7,200
- Website maintenance - £700
- Regional governance structure - £5,250
- Contingency - £2,000
